## Trey Wingate

Trey Wingate, Vice President and Business Unit Leader, is active in an assortment of organizations in the Augusta, GA community, which is why his service designates him our next WK Dickson Community Hero.

Trey currently serves on the board of directors for operations of the Masters City Little League. This is a 100% volunteer organization serving over 400 kids each year from the ages of 4-18. Besides participating in field construction and maintenance operations, Trey also coaches a 4-year old team and an 11-12 year old team, and has coached all star teams for the league for that past 4 seasons. Over the past two years he has lead negotiations for the league to secure long term lease agreements with the state properties commission and Richmond County for approximately 25 additional acres of land to allow for growth and security of this program.

Trey also serves as a volunteer for CSRA Crusaders, which provides spring baseball programs for home school kids and private school kids that do not have a school sponsored program. The program supports around 40 kids each year and fields a middle school, JV and Varsity program. Trey's service helps with scheduling, fundraising and program coordination for the season each year.

This year Trey is also serving as President of the Georgia Society of Professional Engineers (GSPE). Trey has served as secretary and vice-president at the state level in the past, as well as president of the Augusta Chapter for two years. One of the major initiatives of GSPE each year is staffing and funding local and state Mathcounts Competitions for middle school students. Trey has participated in both local and state competitions providing over 1,000 kids an opportunity to match their math skills against some of the brightest young minds in the region. This initiative is aimed at showing kids how mathematics works with engineering.

Trey also serves on the engineering advisory group for A.R. Johnson Health Science and Engineering Magnet School. In this role, Trey works with staff and other professionals to improve opportunities for grade students in the program from extracurricular competitions to intern positions in companies to expose them to the professions they are concentrating in.

Lastly, Trey has served as Scouting Coordinator for Hephzibah United Methodist Church for Pack 149 and Troop 149 in past years and is currently serving on the board of review committee supporting this troop and its activities within the community.
